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How Triple P fidelity data will be collected, including how it will help answer key questions that will drive improvement of local Triple P program and implementation processes.

So many ways to reinforce practitioners' participation in community Triple P fidelity assessment practices:

1. Practitioners are provided an orientation to expectations in the Community-wide Triple P Fidelity Assessment Plan.

2. Practitioners' service delivery agencies integrate Triple P fidelity assessment resources into practitioners' typical service documentation routine.

3. Practitioners and coaches use recent fidelity data during routine Triple P coaching activities.

4. Practitioners see their community coalition use fidelity data to improve Triple P implementation.

5. Practitioners receive a verbal or written "thank you" from their service agency leadership and Community Implementation Team members for turning in fidelity data each month.

6. Practitioners are recognized at community Triple P coalition meetings for having turned in fidelity data.

7. Each quarter, the practitioners that met all community Triple P fidelity assessment expectations get to draw from a [prize bowl](#).
